Position: Officer – Capitol Police – K9 Division

Closing Date: December 20, 2024, 1700 hours (5:00PM)

Hours: 12-hour shift. Must be able to adjust work hours as needed.

Minimum Qualifications: Applicants must possess the following qualifications to apply for the K9 Handler position:

- Minimum of two (2) years of continued sworn service certified (FULL-TIME) through Board on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (BLEOST), and applicant's certificate must be in good standing with the Board on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (BLEOST).
- Be able to complete the MLEOTA physical fitness test at a minimum of seventy percent (70%)
- Have an eighty-five (85) or higher on most recent handgun qualification

Selection Process Includes:

1. Background Investigation
2. Panel Interview Board
3. Physical Fitness Test
4. K9 Interaction Observation
5. Recommendation(s) to the Chief of Police
