**About the Position:** The Building Security/Special Events position (1) will be assigned to the State Capitol building located at 400 High Street, Jackson, MS 39201. Duties will include, but will not be limited to, the following: providing security and transport for State Senators and Representatives, visiting dignitaries, and other people as directed. Be willing to work extra hours and weekends as needed. Must have good communication and conflict resolution skills. Be able to pass a 5-day Protective Service Operations course and lifesaving courses. Must be able to qualify with a patrol rifle and sidearm. (This is a lateral transfer, not a promotion).

#### Minimum Qualifications:

- Three (3) years **full-time certified** law enforcement experience with a municipal, county or state agency in an enforcement position.
- Certified (FULL-TIME) through the Board on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (BLEOST), and Law Enforcement certificate must be in good standing with the Board on Law Enforcement Standards and Training (BLEOST).

2. Panel Interview Board
3. Recommendation(s) to the Chief of Police
